

Directions to Patshull from Wolverhampton



Directions to Patshull from Wolverhampton

- From Wolverhampton, take the A41 (north) towards Cosford & Albrighton.
- Come out from Wolverhampton following the A41 – follow until you reach a fork in the road and take the left fork – A464 towards Shifnal.
- Follow this road for a mile or two. You will go past a pub on the left hand side called “The Horns of Bonningale”
- Take the third small lane on the left after the pub – this is onto Patshull Lane (if you reach the old Lea Manor Hotel on the left that is boarded up you have missed the turn.
- Follow this road until you reach a point where the road itself takes a sharp right turn. There is a turn to the left with a dead end sign and a gate entrance straight on. You will need to turn left into the road with the dead end sign.
- Now follow this narrow road. It takes a sharp right and then sweeps round along the side of a golf course. It will then go over a small bridge and you go through a gate (this should be open.)
- Keep following this track – mind the speed bumps.
- Keep following – you will go around a corner to the right, pass a cottage on the left and then reach a fork in the track – take the track to the left.
- Follow this until you pass a field on the left – there is a flag pole by another fork in the track.
- Follow the track to the left, drop down the hill and we are at the bottom.
