- What will you find in our freshwater moat and stream? Using our collection equipment and identification keys, you'll be amazed at what's living and growing in there.

Learning outcomes

- Bird anatomy and biology.
- Wider animal conservation science.

Typical session structure

- Discuss water safety and what might be found.
- Working in small groups, dip nets into the water and see what they find.
- Move away from the water to identify creatures. Record anything interesting and return to the water.

What to wear

- This activity is all outside, so waterproof/warm clothing when it's wet/cold.

- We will provide the equipment and instructions for you to run this activity.
- **You will need to** provide the leaders to supervise your group in accordance with the [Adult to Young People ratios](#) which specifies that this will be **1:6 for beavers, 1:8 for cubs and 1:12 for scouts** (and for other organisations, following the relevant guidance within your organisation).
